Free Meals Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- 1. Who is allowed to get Free Breakfast & Lunch? Any Hudson student up to age 18
- 2. Do we need to apply or sign up? No, it is automatic.
- Is this for low income families only?
 No, it is for any Hudson student up to age 18.
- 4. My child is learning remotely. Is he/she eligible for free meals? Yes, you must sign up in advance for the following week at: https://www.sau81.org/departments/food_service/remote_meals
- 5. Does my child still have to put in his pin number?
 Yes, we are held accountable to the USDA for each meal we serve.
- Is this for all year?
 Yes, until the end of the 2020-2021 school year. (or until federal funds run out)
- 7. If my student owes money am I still responsible for what is owed?

 Yes, any transactions prior to October 14th, 2020 are still owed and should be paid as soon as possible.
- 8. Will I get refunded the money on my child's account?
 - We recommend leaving money on the account to allow the child to purchase snacks and incidental ala carte for the remainder of the year. (Approx. 140 days left)
 - Any funds left over will roll over to the next year.
 - Funds can be transferred between siblings.
 - Written refund requests will be processed once a month, and at the end of the school year.
 - Funds can be donated to a student in need for snacks and supplemental ala carte.
- 9. Do I still need to file a meals benefit application? We highly recommend and encourage everyone to fill out a meals benefit application. It can be found on the Food Service web page www.sau81.org. Other district funding is based on these applications such as; Title 1-family & community, Title 3-ESOL programs, discounts for Internet service, discounts for Summer Rec program, discounts for SAT fees, discounts for other community programs.
- 10. Will money in the account be used first, before going to free?
 No, every student is free from October 14th to the end of the year
- 11. Will I get reimbursed from the start of school?

 No. Meals from Sept 8th to October 13th are not reimbursable by the Federal Govt or the district.
