Assessment Guidelines:

- All classes will meet for one, 90-minute period during the assessment week. Teachers may use the period for either assessment or instruction (or some combination of both).
- Students must attend the scheduled period(s) for each of their classes. Administrative permission is required to change an assessment time, including make-up. Juniors who met SAT benchmarks may be exempted from the final assessment period in math and/or American Humanities with permission of the teacher.
- 3. Strategies for Success, GOALS, and ESOL sections will meet as usual.
- 4. No managed time during the assessment days, but students may work in designated areas including the cafeteria, library, and Academic Support Center.
- 5. Normal school attendance policies and procedures apply. Students who are absent from school may not participate in co-curricular activities or athletics on that day.
- 6. Teachers will work with students during the make-up/remediation periods. Students may also go to the library, Academic Support Center, or another designated space for work time and academic support.
- 7. Math support will be available in the ASC during the assessment week. Students may continue to work with GOALS, Strategies, and/or Math Support teachers through the remediation and grading periods.
- 8. School Counselors will be available for support and 2023-2024 planning.
- 9. Bus service will be provided on the normal morning schedule and after the second assessment period each day (11:15). A late bus will also run at 1:00 after the remediation periods on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.
- 10. Limited cafeteria service will be available on the assessment days through pre-orders.
